show as follows:

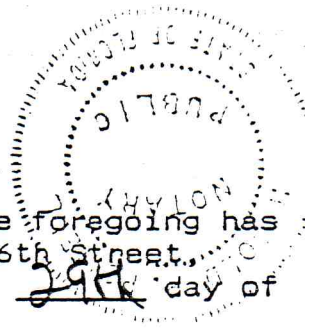
- 1.) Defendant no longer has confidence in the ability of assigned
