Dear Mr. Rowe:

I am in receipt of your letter dated February 21, 2006 regarding Mr. Armstrong's claims that he had difficulty making telephonic contact with his counsel in his first degree murder case, Mr. Hilliard Moldof.

It is my understanding that Mr. Armstrong's chief complaint with regard to the phone is not that he does **not** get access to the telephone, but rather he does not receive access to a **free** phone reserved for those inmates who are proceeding pro se in their criminal cases, and who have a court Order for such access. With regard to that issue, I appeared with Mr. Moldof at a hearing before Judge Gates, and the Judge indicated that Mr. Armstrong was to receive phone privileges consistent with other inmates in the Broward County Jail, no more/no less.

It is my understanding that Mr. Armstrong's phone privileges are consistent with other inmates at his custody level. To the extent that you have information to the contrary, please provide me with the specifics and I will happy to look into it.
