Compeling Compliance

Defense motion to declare defendant Indigent for costs is granted. Defense is to utilize electronic court reporting services for depositions and Broward Sheriff's office for service of subpoenas or other state officers. The sheriff shall allow the defendant use of telephones at no cost and not requiring collect calls so that defendant may set hearing, deposition, and aid and assistance within investigation, etc. and other matters related solely to his cases.

The defendant was deemed Indigent for costs. This court here by sanction the Broward county main jail, and F.D.O.C. against any further fees, and other the Broward Sheriff's office to refund any and all charges of the fee, cause defendant is a state prisoner who already deemed Indigent. The court hereby order the main jail to compliance allow defendant to attend the law library consistent with respect of due process rights, and constitutional laws. Which defendant may researching on the laws, make copies, access to telephone calls, without any further impadment in the Broward county main jail, and the Florida Department of corrections, "access to nornal ink pens, and type writer-computer, etc. The court further orderd release of defendant contact card, and receipts to defendant and his attorneys, etc. and his investigators, under Chatper 119, and other discovery rules to release defendant personal propery to his attorneys, etc. and investigators as soon as possible. Any further records which being witheld from the defense. Any further delay which may deem as additional breach of duty.
